Survey Methodology*

	Survey Details
Mode	Phone (landline and mobile) Online (email and text to web)
Language	English and Spanish
Length	5 minutes
Target Respondents	California voters
Survey Fielding	May 13 - 19, 2026
Margin of Error	+/-3.3%
Survey Participants	1000

Sample

The sample was developed from the voter file. We called, emailed, and texted voters. We matched the demographics of California likely Primary Election voters.

Data Collection Explained

Interviews were conducted with live U.S.-based interviewers by phone (13%) and online survey methods (87%). Phone participants were interviewed through landline (31%) and mobile (69%) calls. Online participants were invited by email (43%) and text message (57) to access the survey by computer, tablet, or smart phone.

Respondents in all modes chose their preferred language, English (92%) and Spanish (8%).

Security measures precluded individuals from completing the survey more than once.

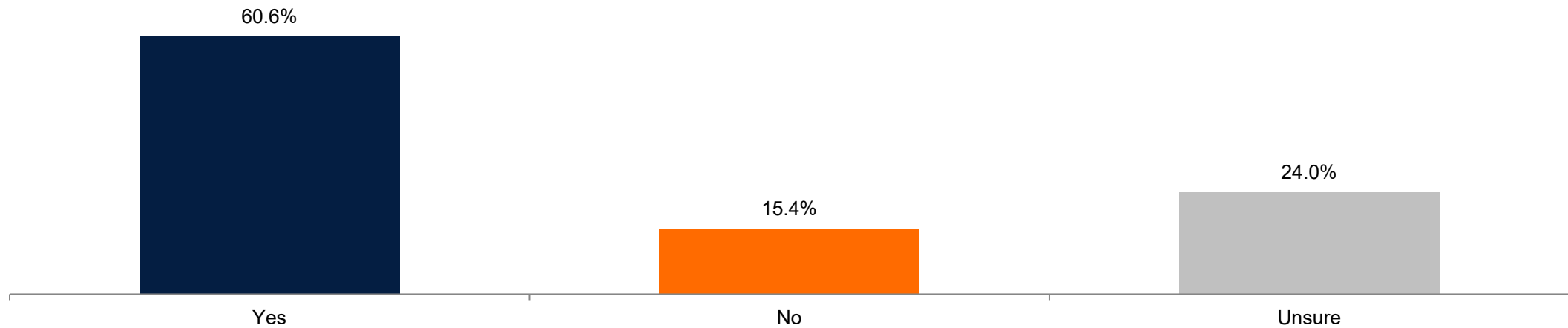

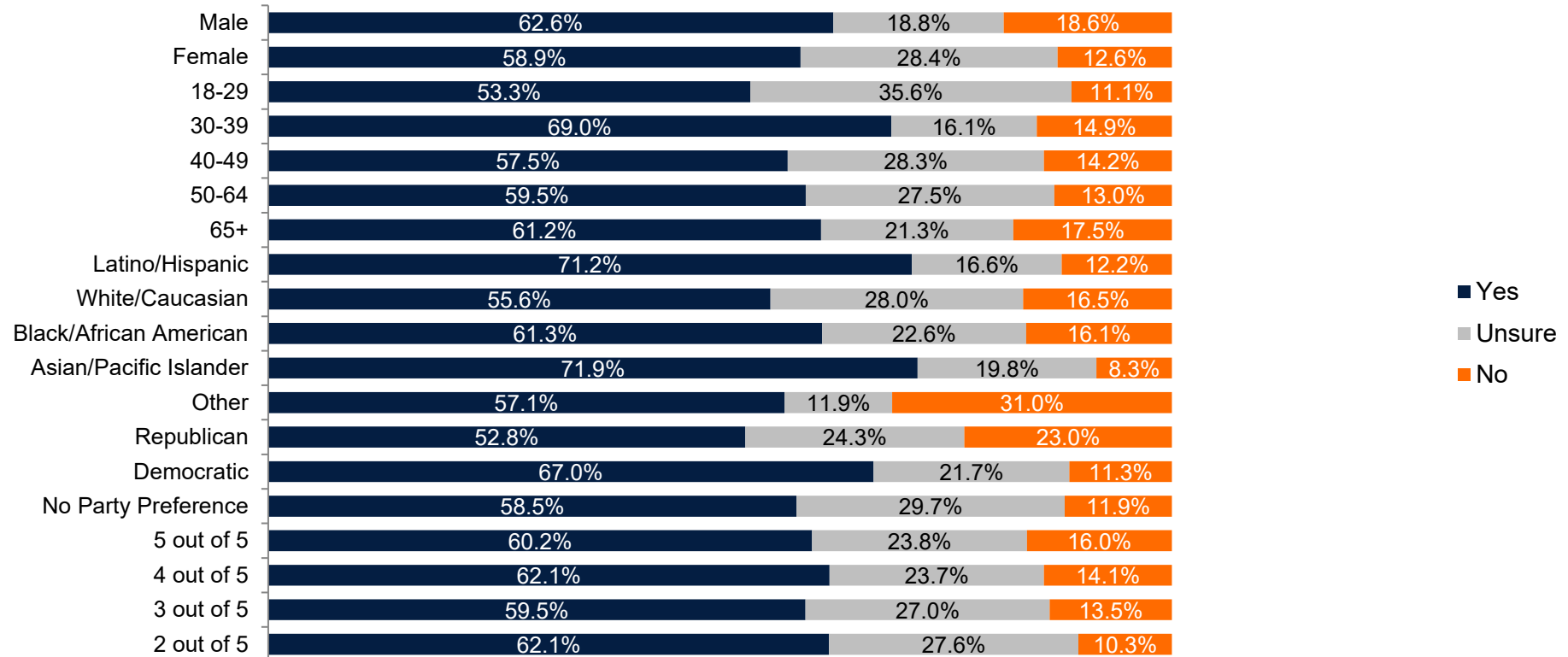

Question: Should Yosemite National Park's Hetch Hetchy Valley be restored, if it can be accomplished without impacting San Francisco's water supply?



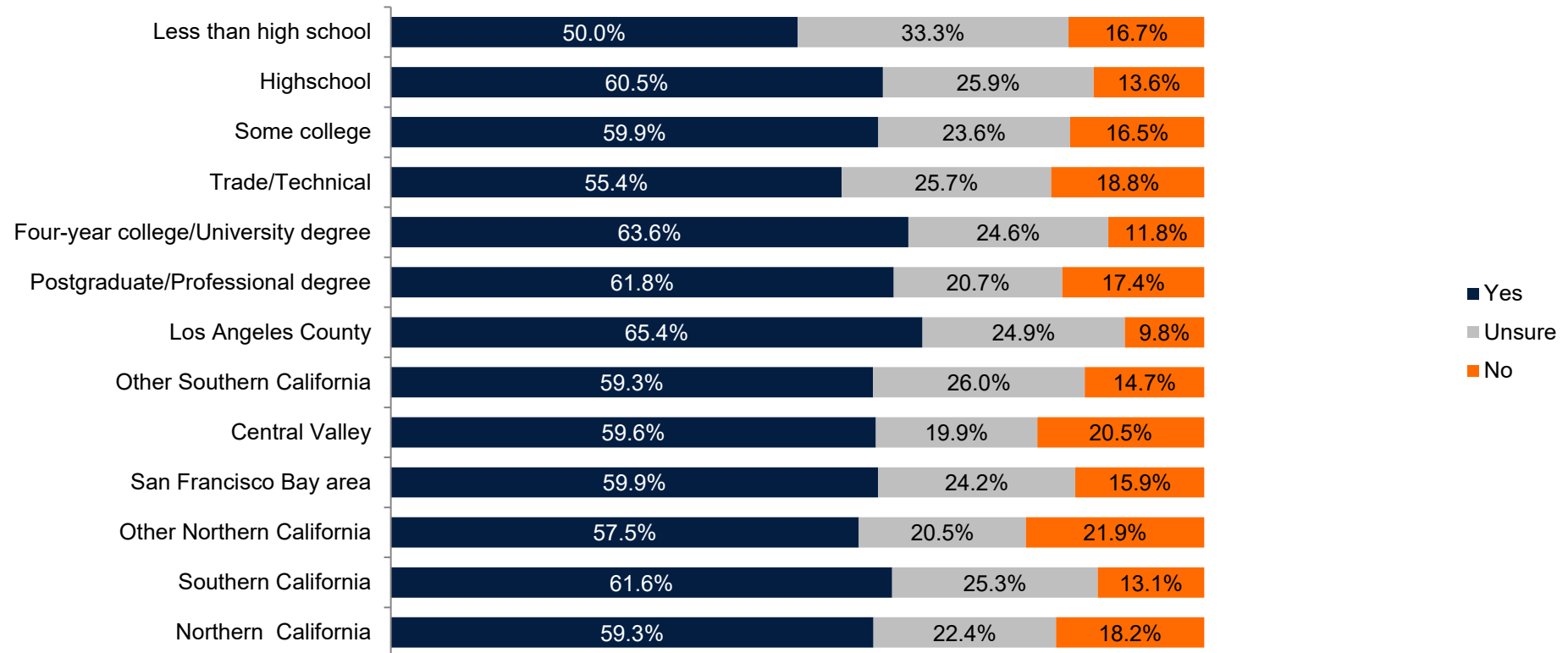
Results by gender, age group, ethnicity, political party and vote propensity

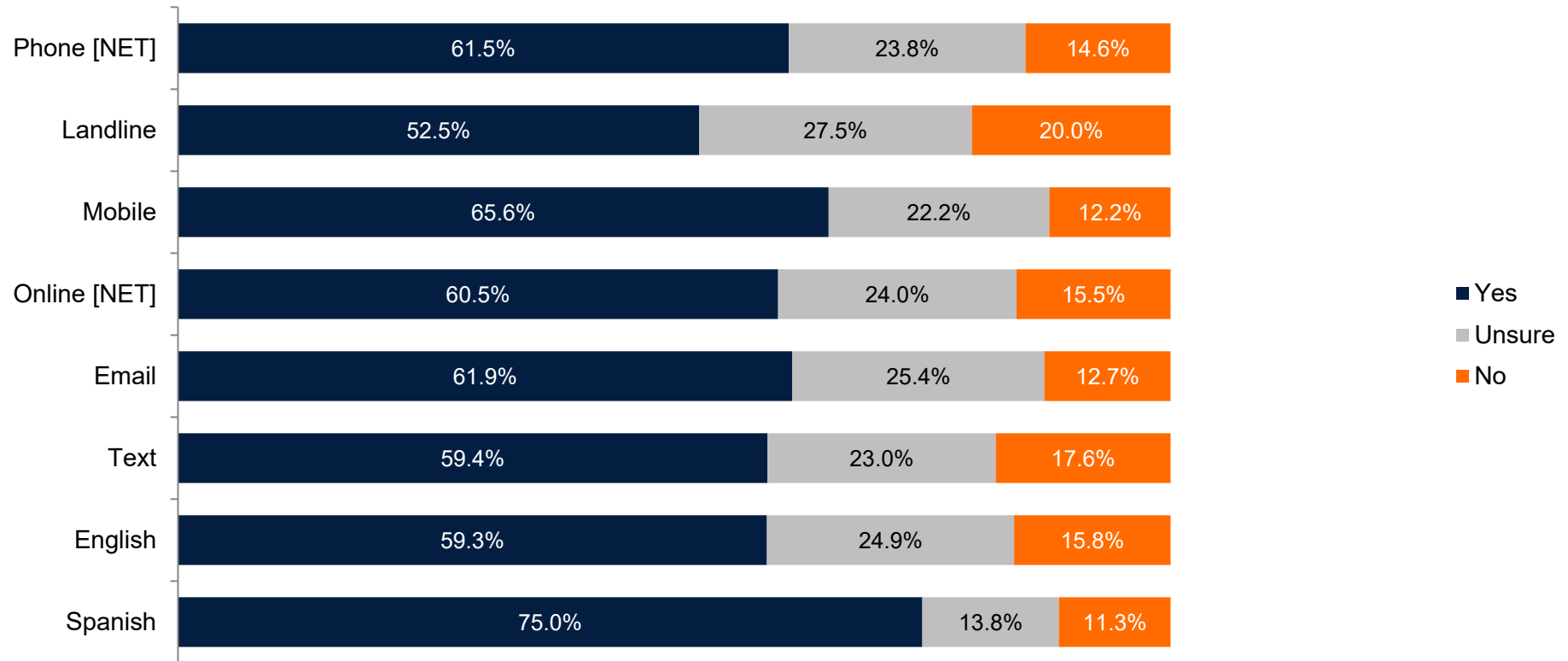
Results by education and geography

Results by survey mode and survey language

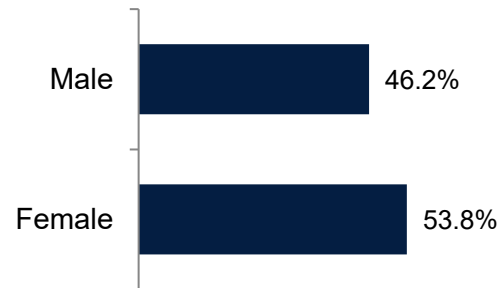

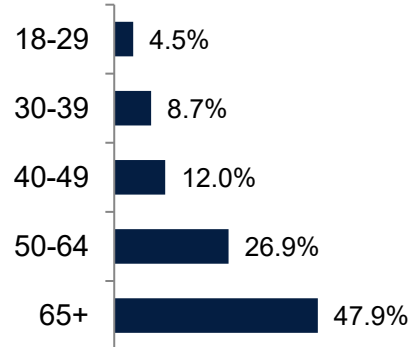

Respondent demographics by gender, age, ethnicity, vote propensity, education, party preference, and geography

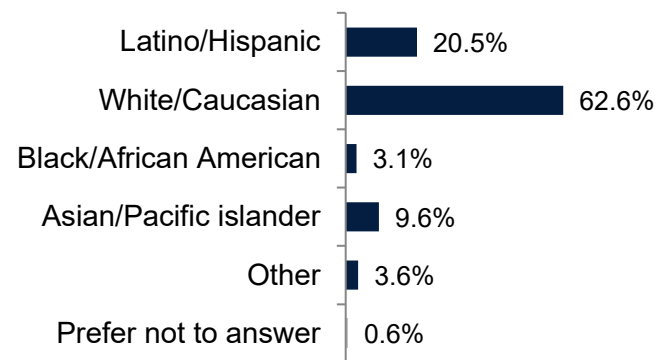

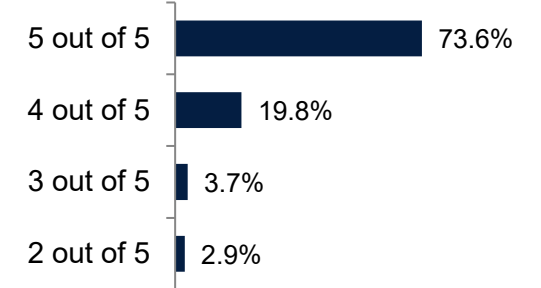
Age



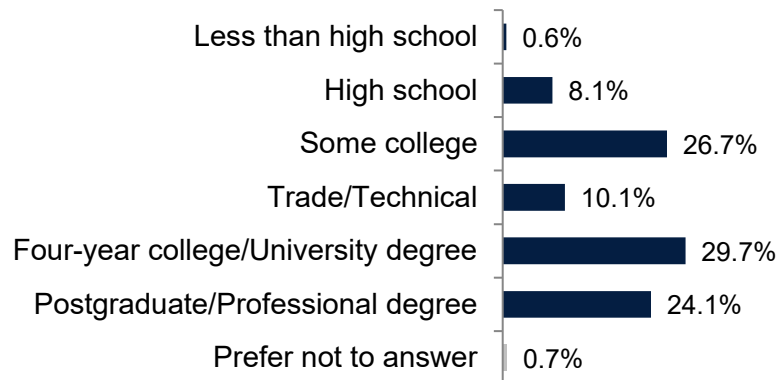
Ethnicity



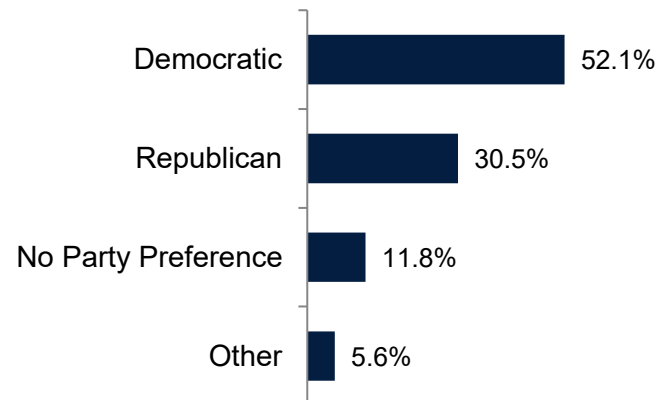
Vote Propensity



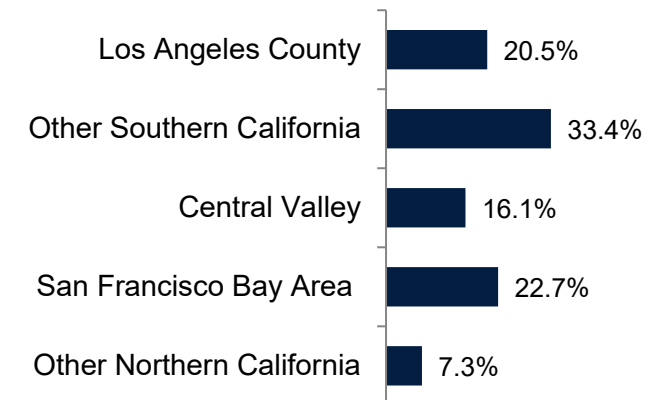
Education
